



### **Items for patients to bring**

- 2 changes of daytime clothing, underwear, socks
- Sleepwear - pajamas, sweats
- Sweater / jacket or long sleeved shirts
- Sturdy shoes that fit (NO LACES)
- Wheelchair
- Glasses, hearing aids, dentures
- C-Pap machine (if applicable)

### **Optional items**

- Topical ointments, creams, eye drops
- Hygiene items / Electric razors only
- Familiar items – comforter, stuffed animal
- Down time activities - book, word puzzles

### **Do not bring**

- Purses, wallets, jewelry, cell phones, pocket knives, computers or electronic gadgets, sewing/crochet needles, pets, money, tobacco/lighter, belts or suspenders, roller walker, electric wheelchair

### **Visiting Hours – Currently by Appointment**

*Maximum of two visitors per patient/day. All visitors must have their temperature\* recorded prior to entry to the unit. Safety is our first priority. Masks will be worn for the duration of the visit. Visitation will be limited to people over 12 years of age. Visitation time will be scheduled to control the number of persons on the unit and to allow disinfection between visits. If staff feel the unit cannot be safely managed, you may be asked to leave early. Any inappropriate behavior that causes distress to patients, family, or staff will not be tolerated and may be result in termination of the visit.*

All items brought to patients must be checked at the nursing station and approved by unit staff.

*\* **Do not visit** if you have any of the following symptoms: fever, sore throat, chills, cough, shortness of breath, muscle aches, diarrhea, headache, recent loss of taste or smell. A temperature  $\geq 100.4^\circ$  will prevent entry.*

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
